KAUA'I VETERANS MEMORIAL HOSPITAL

The Hawaii Health Systems Corporation, Kaua'i Region, Kaua'i Veterans Memorial Hospital is a 25 bed Critical Access Hospital with a 20 bed Skilled Nursing Facility on the west side of Kaua'i. It was built to meet the increasing medical needs of the people in the surrounding communities. Over the years, the Hospital has listened to its community and added outpatient primary care clinics and one urgent care clinic strategically located on the Island (The Clinics at Waimea, Port Allen, Kalaheo, Poipu, Kapa'a and the Urgent Care at Poipu). KVMH employs approximately 280 employees and provides the following inpatient/outpatient services: 24-Hour Emergency Services, Critical Care/ICU, Medical/Surgical Care, Obstetrical Services, Pediatric Services, Skilled Nursing Care, Inpatient/Outpatient Surgery, Imaging Services, Rehab Services, and many more.

KVMH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION

The KVMH Charitable Foundation was established as a 501©3 back in 1999. It was formed with several board members, individuals from the Hospital and community volunteers. The main mission of the Foundation is to assist with the purchasing of unfunded equipment for the Hospital by fundraising and grant writing.

Some of the items purchased by the Foundation includes: lights for surgery, cardiac stress monitoring equipment, a neonatal simulator ("Baby Annie"), childbirth material, laser c—arm for radiology, GlidaScope for Anesthesia, furniture for the Port Allen Clinic, bariatric bed, and shared construction costs for the Triage Room in the Emergency Department.

In addition, a grant of \$80,000 was received for the new Hospital Furniture.
